

#### MRS. RALLO'S PERIOD 4 TMC CLASS

The students in my period 4 class have been working hard to build their comprehension skills. They have already learned about fact/opinion, reading for details, and making predictions. Students watched educational videos that introduced these concepts. Samantha, Tristen, George, Matt, and Ethan made a poster for each skill then completed hands-on activities. For fact/opinion, the students had to read a card and decide whether it was a fact or an opinion. If it was a fact, they had to get their iPads and prove it. If it was an opinion, they said, "It's what I feel" OR "It's what I think". When learning how to make a prediction, the students viewed pictures and had to determine what they felt would happen next. Students learned that predictions can change as a story unfolds. The students made nice progress after completing these multisensory activities. They always come to class with a smile on their face willing to do their best work. Keep up the great work, Samantha, Ethan, Matt, Tristen, and George.

#### MS. VANDENBREE'S CLASS NEWS
